What Will I Do?

Work collaboratively with secondary and primary teachers and students, instructing national and international students in a variety of subjects.

Volunteers will spend time in the classroom in teaching roles, and as mentors with local students undertaking their education in the English language. You may also be asked to share your teaching experiences with local staff to enhance their professional development.

What will I learn?

Interpersonal, communication, professional skills, teamwork, critical thinking and cultural awareness.

Where:

An international English language school in Shanghai.

Suitable for:

Education/Teaching (Secondary and Primary) 2nd, 3rd or 4th year undergraduate or post graduate students. Secondary Education/Teaching students must major in Math/ English/ Physics/ Chemistry or Business



YOUR ITINERARY

Day 1:

Arrive in Shanghai, check-in to school accommodation

Day 2+3:

Self directed Cultural Orientation - The Bund, Zhujiajiao Ancient Town, Night River Cruise, Oriental Pearl Tower

Day 4:

Orientation and induction at host organisation

Day 5 - End:

Placement at host organisation (5 days a week)*

Final Day:

Depart Shanghai and return home
